Preliminary assembly...

- Once all the tiles were made, Guild members built the mosaic in two stages, first using the leaves and then the wave pieces
- These builds were photographed, then divided into sections and moved into boxes for transportation to the bathhouse
- Given the circular nature of the space where the tiles were going to go, the land/water design "loosened" up and while still representing land and water, colour was used to move the eye around the circular layout with cooler colours on the water side and warmer colours on the land side

At the Bathhouse, finally...

- The installation process was started May 2, 2023 when mosaic group members gathered to lay out (again) the tiles for the mosaic on tables at the bathhouse
- The layout was recreated on long tables and then transferred in sections up to the scaffolding for installation
- Liability issues meant that guild members could not access the scaffold and the City hired professional tile installers to mount all the pieces and grout them under the supervision of the guild members
- Gary from Eastern Ontario Terrazzo & Tile arrived on May 3 and Pete joined in on May 4
- After applying a scratch coat to the area to be tiled, Gary installed all of the border tiles and then the backbone tiles
- We then handed sections of the mosaic, arranged on boards, corresponding to ~60 by 30 cm regions, up to the installers on the scaffold



The missaid includes over one thousand ties that were hundrade, coloured, placed and fined by the Guid, with the periodipation of moderns through a variety of sessions held at the fact Centre for Creativity and Lawreng. The ties have been combined to represent the tend and water, while the colour progression around the motaci represents ongoing change. The motaci was installed by Eastern Onterio Terratio & Tile Company Ltd. under the appreciation of the Culat. Spectrum Discuss generously storated places used for the motaci.

Project Background

in March 1967, the resuly fernise Ringston Coramists' Guild heat their first public meeting at the Richardson Breach. Batthouse, Later that year, the Guild successfully applied to the City of Kingston to provide support for vertication and acquament after the beatment of the Batthouse was made available. From 1975 to 2010, the revenuest Kingston Putters' Guild was relocated to the J.K. Tatt Creativity Centre along acts other arts groups. Following the City's decimen to reservate the J.K.
